EWI Receives Microbiological Test Results on MD1000

Environmental Waste International Inc. ("EWI") is very pleased to announce that the microbiological results from the recent testing conducted at EWI's commercial installation in Liverpool, England (UK) have been completely successful. The testing was conducted and monitored by one of the UK Government's licensed and accredited laboratories and were conducted under the recommendations as set out in the Environment Agency's (EA) September 2001 draft Technical Guidelines, Version 2.2.

As quoted in the report's summary: "None of the test bacteria impregnated in bone, meat, fabric and present in meat enriched broth cultures, were detected after passing through the decontamination unit. Therefore the required 6-log reduction was exceeded for all test organisms during this decontamination run." "There was no evidence of microbial environmental contamination arising from the unit, as confirmed by air and effluent sampling."

The report confirms the MD1000's ability to totally sterilize all tested pathogens including E-Coli, Vegetative Bacteria, Bacterial Spores and Fungi. All pathogens used were to Level III STAATT. The tests were performed using worst-case scenarios where the pathogens were treated in the presence of typical waste, injected into animal shanks and bones and positioned at various locations throughout the waste. The tests also included contaminated needles and syringes positioned throughout the load.

"We believe that these results prove, beyond any doubt, that EWI's Medical Waste Processor represents the most advanced waste treatment and sterilization system available on the market today. We further believe that our medical waste reduction units have set a new standard in sterilization that other systems will now have to compete with", stated Dr. Stephen
